## **The History of the Debutante Season**

The word, “debutante”, is derived from the French word, “debater”, which means, “to lead off.”

The debutante tradition, as we know it in the United States, has its roots in England. The idea that a girl should be presented to society stems from the time when a daughter of a marriageable age needed to find a husband of suitable and similar social standing. The daughters of the landed aristocracy, the lords and ladies of England married within a very small circle and often had a very large dowry that went with them.

The court of the kings and queens of England is known as the court of St. James (“the Court”). It was the center of all power. Because of the weather and the requirements of the hunt, the Court was held in London from April until the end of July. During this time, the aristocracy came in from their country homes and opened their city houses and the social season commenced.

After the Industrial Revolution, as the middle class began to make large sums of money, the aristocrats were anxious to make alliances with wealthy entrepreneurs. The middle-class daughters could be presented if they could find a sponsor from among the aristocracy. The Season started with the presentation to the Court during which the young lady bowed to the Queen, thus the name the St. James Bow. Parties followed this, each family giving their share. It was hoped that at the end of the season, a girl would have found a husband.

The idea of the presentation of young women to society started in this country in 1748 when 59 colonial Philadelphia families held “Dancing Assemblies”, the forerunner to the Debutante Ball. The tradition continues today throughout the United States with the majority of balls being held from November through January.

### ***The History of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. Debutante Program in Boston, Massachusetts***

*The Psi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. has sponsored debutante programs in Boston for over 40 years. The first program was offered in 1973. Similar to its existing youth development programs, which provide education and positive growth development and mentoring, the 2018-2019 Precious Pearls Debutante Program, sponsored in collaboration with The Boston Pearl Foundation, Inc., targets young women of color enrolled in grades 10 -12. In an era where images of women in various media and entertainment mediums are disturbingly negative, the Precious Pearls Debutante Program gives young women of color within the greater Boston area a positive self-image, role models and personal development activities that promote high moral and ethical standards. The six-month program culminates with a formal Cotillion that allows the community to acknowledge and celebrate the efforts of the debutantes to mature into cultured, confident, principled and civic-minded women.*

## Program Sponsor Overview



**The Boston Pearl Foundation, Incorporated** was established in August 2005 by the members of the Psi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. as a vehicle to expand the scope of scholarly assistance and community enrichment available in the Boston area. One mission of the Foundation is to advance and support education by providing underserved students with the financial assistance needed to attend college. Specifically, the focus of the Foundation is to further the education of young Black women who enroll as freshmen in a four-year college or university. The second purpose of the Foundation is to support charitable community programming in the

greater Boston area. This is accomplished by supporting programs that provide services to improve the health and social livelihood of all persons in the community ( particularly communities of color) and to educate the public on issues that impact the same. **Psi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated** was established in 1926 and is the oldest graduate chapter of the sorority within the New England states. For 100 years, Psi Omega Chapter has maintained an ongoing commitment to promote leadership development among Black women, support scholarship awards to promising young women, and provide financial and in-kind assistance to initiatives important to the welfare of Black people. For instance, Psi Omega Chapter grants monetary scholarships and gifts annually to

young women graduating from greater Boston-area high schools who are entering institutions of higher education. In 1932, Psi Omega Chapter presented its first scholarship of \$75.00. Since then, more than \$200,000 has been awarded to deserving college-bound students from the greater Boston area. Through the Precious Pearls Debutante Program, Psi Omega Chapter and The Boston Pearl Foundation, Inc. foster the development of young women by providing mentoring, educational enrichment, and community service opportunities. Psi Omega sponsors a college fair where admission representatives and alumni from various Historically Black Colleges and Universities interact with high school students through one-on-one sessions and workshops. Under Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.'s international programs, Psi Omega donated backpacks filled with school supplies to students and dresses to the African Girls' Dress Project. Psi Omega Chapter has also supported national initiatives such as combating the COVID-19 pandemic, Sickle Cell Anemia Research, the Sudden Infant Death Syndrome Alliance, Alzheimer's Association and Breast Cancer Awareness and Research. Please note that all monies submitted to The Boston Pearl Foundation, Inc. are non-refundable, regardless of the reason for or time of withdrawal.

Your efforts will culminate in a magical evening at the Debutante Ball, the black-tie event held on June 6, 2026, featuring you and recognizing your academic, professional and cultural growth. On that evening, you will be presented to society as Debutantes on the arms of your escorts and under the proud and watchful eyes of your friends, family, and the Boston community. We implore you to make the most of this unique cultural experience and enjoy your presentation and announcement to the world that you are coming!

## Debutante Qualifications & Responsibilities

- She must be currently enrolled in the 10-12<sup>th</sup> grade of a high school (or homeschooled) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- She must pay the non-refundable commitment fee of \$ 150.00 and meet the minimum \$1500.00 fundraising commitment and other financial obligations as required.
- She, along with her escort, must attend rehearsals and arrive on time.
- She, along with her escort, must adhere to the rules and regulations set by Boston Pearl Foundation Incorporated and Psi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated.
- She must be in good standing in her school and community.
- She must not be a mother.
- She must not now be or become pregnant during the Debutante Program season.
- She must complete an application and biographical sketch.
- She must submit a parental permission form signed by her parent(s) or guardian(s).
- She must participate in Cotillion activities.
- She must be amenable to acquiring characteristics and qualities that would lend themselves to desirable social behavior.

## Escort Qualifications & Responsibilities

- Escort must be age 15-19 years of age currently enrolled in the 10-12<sup>th</sup> grade of a high school (or home schooled) or college.
- Escort must pay the non-refundable participation fee.
- Escort must have demonstrated leadership potential (i.e., academic, athletic, religious, etc.) and participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Escort must not be a father.
- Escort must complete an application and biographical sketch.
- Escort must participate in Cotillion activities.
- Escort must be amenable to acquiring characteristics and qualities that would lend themselves to desirable social behavior.

# Debutante Expectations & Rules

**Attendance** Debutantes must participate in every monthly activity. More than two unexcused absences disqualify the debutante for a title opportunity. Three unexcused absences will require the debutante to discontinue the program and relinquish all funds raised in the name of the Boston Pearl Foundation, Inc. Please direct attendance issues to the attention of Laronica Lightfoot, Debutante Co-Chairman.

## Fundraising

Each debutante is required to:

- Raise \$1,500 through debutante sponsorships or advertisements for the souvenir journal
- Sell a minimum of 4 tickets to the formal debutante ball.

Refer to **Appendix B** for appropriate submission forms.

A fundraising web page will be created for each debutante to publicize the 2019 Cotillion, your accomplishments/interests, and community service to aid in reaching your fundraising goals. Debutantes are discouraged from creating additional fundraising pages. However, should you choose to use alternative platform(s), any self-created fundraising web pages/sites must be submitted for review and approval by the Debutante Committee and state collection “on behalf of the Boston Pearl Foundation” in your name.

## Debutante Fee(s)

Debutantes are required to pay a non-refundable commitment fee of \$250.00, plus participate in fundraising activities raising a minimum of \$1,500.00. Funds attained through fundraising may be paid in installments according to the established payment timeline and reporting procedures.

**NOTE:** The Boston Pearl Foundation, Incorporated and the Psi Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated reserves the right to request the withdrawal of any debutante who does not adhere to the foregoing regulation or any other regulation which jeopardizes the welfare of our organization.

If for any reason a Debutante wishes to withdraw, she and her parent/guardian must notify Cotillion Co-Chairman, Daphney Pacouloute at 617.980.9114 immediately and follow up in writing via email to preciouspearls2026@gmail.com. After December 1, 2025, all program fees submitted to The Boston Pearl Foundation, Inc. are nonrefundable. All fundraising monies collected in the name of The Boston Pearl Foundation are nonrefundable.

**No portion of the fee will be returned to the debutante.**

**All monies are nonrefundable whatever the reason for the withdrawal.**

# Escort Expectations & Rules

## Attendance

Escorts must be able to commit to attending necessary rehearsals and certain activities designed to prepare young men for adulthood.

## Respect

Escorts are expected to conduct themselves like gentlemen and treat adults, women, and debutantes with respect. Inappropriate behavior/conduct or bad language will not be tolerated – no exceptions.

## Escort Fee(s)

Escorts are required to pay a non-refundable commitment fee of \$150.00. The commitment fee covers professional development workshops and boutonnière.
